

#### NOG Homes For Sale as of June 2013

The overall market had closed sales up + 1.8% versus June of 2012 and pending sales up + 24.4% over the same month last year!

Inventory has increased by 49 units, or + 1.2% from last month. The average sale price in June was \$191,000, up \$14,000 from last year. Prices are starting to rise and this is the highest average sold price within the last year. Homes sold in June also spent an average of 73 days on market, which is the lowest days on market number within the last year
